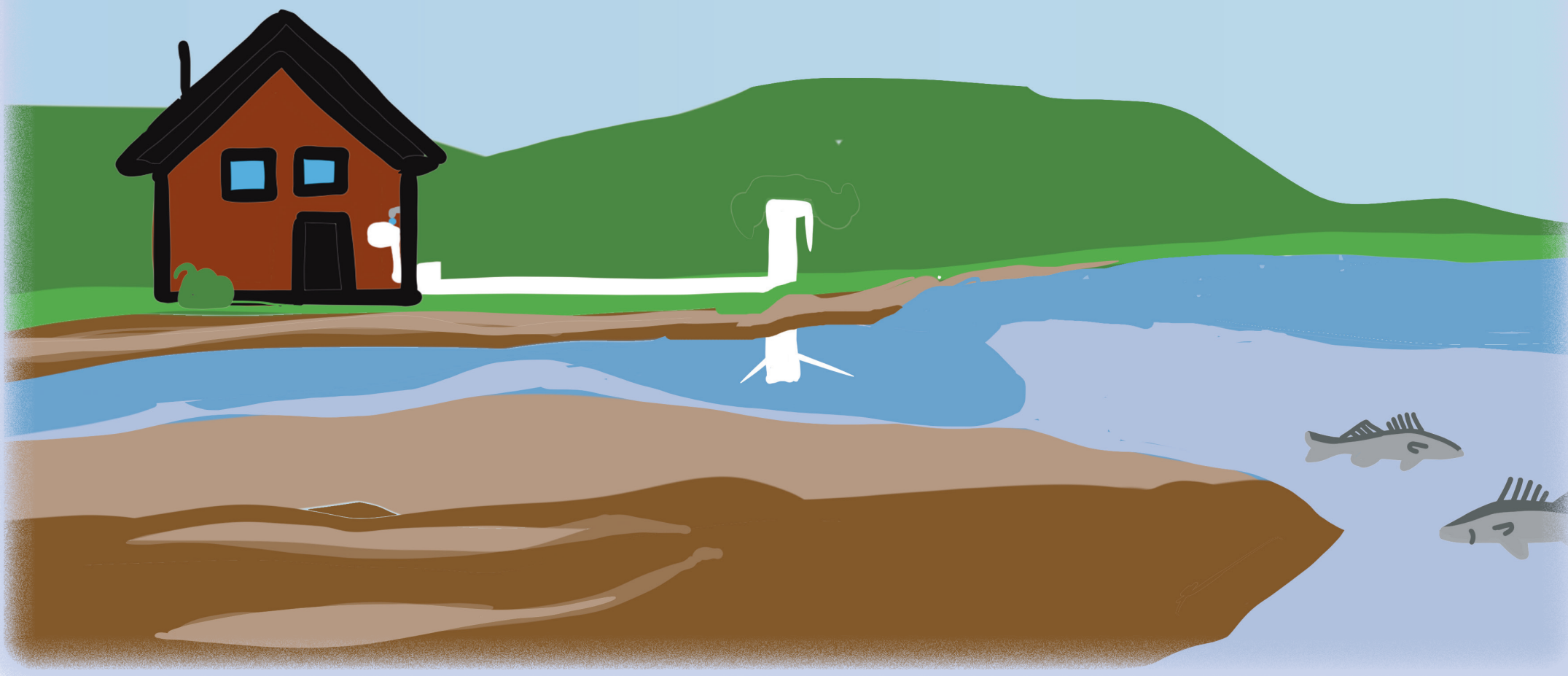


# STORY OF THE FUTURE

Community is aware of food production needs

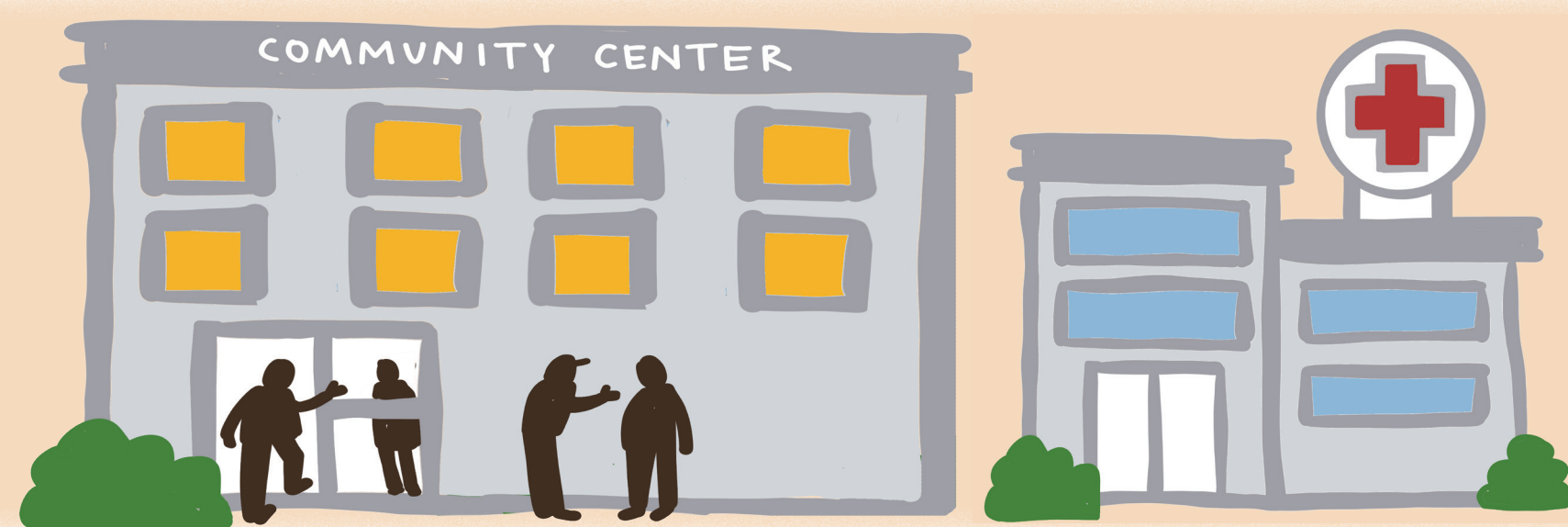
### FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR STEWARDSHIP
